REPORTS

Jim Moustis, Frankfort Township Supervisor, reported that the work continues at Landings Pointe Senior Housing. There was a sprinkler system malfunction in the club house. Water damage will be covered by insurance. The club house interior at Landings Pointe will be complete in a few weeks.

Bill Carlson, Highway Commissioner, described the Highway Department's snow removal procedures. No roads were ever closed. Pay loaders and snow pushers were used to clear the cul de sacs and dead ends.

Next winter the Highway Department will put into effect a new Snow Parking Ordinance. It will prohibit street parking whenever a 2-inch or more snowfall occurs. Any snowbound vehicles on the streets will be towed at the owners' expense. This allows the Highway Department to safely remove snow and ice from our streets. We will be notifying residents by mail in advance on all the details of the new ordinance this summer.

Nella Piccolin, Township Clerk, attended an early voter's class at the Will County Clerk's Office. There was a demonstration on how to use the county's new voting system.
