CALL TO ORDER

Town Clerk, Nella Piccolin, called the meeting to order at 7 p.m.
Pledge of Allegiance followed led by Edward Ronkowski.

SELECTION, OATH AND FEE OF MODERATOR

James Moustis moved and Joseph Kral seconded a motion for Hugh Stipan to be selected as moderator of the meeting. Motion approved.

Hugh Stipan took the Oath of Office of Moderator of the Annual Town Meeting.
James Moustis entertained a motion to establish a \$75.00 moderator's fee and Joseph Kral seconded the motion. Motion approved.

APPROVAL OF 2015 ANNUAL TOWN MEETING MINUTES

Edward Ronkowski moved and Joe Kral seconded a motion to approve as submitted the minutes of the 2015 Annual Town Meeting held April 14, 2015. Motion approved.

APPOINTMENT, FEE FOR AUDITOR

David J. Smith moved and Gregory Griffin seconded a motion to appoint Senesac and Lennon Ltd. as the certified public accountants to perform an annual audit of the Town accounts and for the Town to appropriate sufficient funds to pay for these services. Motion approved.

SUPERVISORS'S REPORT/SUMMARY OF ACCOUNTS

James Moustis then read the Supervisor's Report/Summary of Accounts (copy attached).
Joseph Kral moved and Nick George seconded motion to approve the Supervisor's Report/Summary of Accounts as read. Motion approved.

ASSESSOR'S REPORT

Joseph Kral, Township Assessor, reported that in 2016 we have \$5,282,782,311.00 of residential property. A little shy of one billion dollars in commercial and 417 million dollars in industrial property. For a total of \$6,682,460,808.00 evaluation in our township in 2015. We have seen a slight decrease in our commercial valuation. We see more housing sales. The Township grew in overall value by \$67,454,711.00. David J. Smith moved and George Tolsky seconded a motion to accept the Assessor's report as delivered. Motion approved.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

Highway Commissioner Bill Carlson reported that the 2016 inventory of all machinery and tools was updated and a copy filed with the Road District Clerk. The Road District is currently responsible for maintaining approximately 67 miles of road under its jurisdictional

administrative authority. Projects for 2016 are completion of tree replacement due to the Emerald Ash Borer, roadway improvements, building and salt storage building repairs, and ditching and culvert upgrades. David J. Smith moved and Joseph Kral seconded a motion to approve the Highway Commissioner's report as delivered. Motion approved.
